JOB SUMMARY: Skilled work in the maintenance and servicing of cars, trucks and other City equipment (heavy and small). Work performed under the general direction of the Superintendent of Operations. Over-time may be required in call out situations.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Performs mechanical and service work on all City vehicles and equipment.

- ◆ Cleans and washes automobiles, trucks, and other equipment.
- ◆ Greases, lubricates, and changes fluids in cars, trucks and other equipment.
- ◆ Picks up repair parts as required.
- ◆ Repairs tires, inflates tires to prescribed pressure.
- ◆ Replaces windshield wipers, air filters, oil filters, and other accessories.
- ◆ Inspects or replace batteries, fan belts, and water hoses.
- ◆ Picks up/delivers vehicles.
- ◆ Supports other divisions in the operation of vehicles and equipment.
- ◆ Service generators.
- ◆ Repair and maintain light equipment such as chain saws, weed eaters, and lawn mowers.
- ◆ Repair and maintain heavy equipment, including backhoe, bucket truck and grapple truck and pump out boat.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- ◆ Knowledge of assembly, adjustment and maintenance of a wide variety of automotive, truck and equipment.

- ◆ Capable of reading and understanding wiring diagrams for troubleshooting equipment.
- ◆ Knowledge of all types of shop tools.
- ◆ Ability to follow directions and have a mechanical aptitude
- ◆ Ability to diagnose the defects of worn or broken parts on equipment
- ◆ Skill in applying methods and techniques in the use of automotive or diesel repairs.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: High School graduation or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. At least four (4) years of mechanical experience in the automotive/truck repair areas.

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS: Possession of a valid Class "B" Commercial Driver's License. A.S.E. certified in the truck or automotive field, or equivalent certification

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS: Must have acceptable eyesight and hearing (with or without correction). Must be able to communicate both orally and writing. Must be able to lift and carry heavy objects (45 lbs. and over). Must be able to reach, climb, pull and push objects.
