Summary: The George Washington Carver Community Center has submitted a Special Event Permit application for the upcoming Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade to be held January 20, 2014. Lineup will begin at 9:00 AM along NE 7th Avenue; the parade will begin at 10:00 AM along SR 44 to NE 9th Avenue and end at Copeland Park.

There will be a partial road closing along SR 44 to accommodate the parade which will be coordinated by the Sheriff's Department. This item is being handled through a special Council meeting inasmuch as the application was just received within the city offices and FDOT will not consider the application without the City already having taken action on it.


